



## 2021 Team Championship

*This traditional Oakbrook staple is one of the biggest tournaments of the year if not the largest purse! Two man teams play for a large calcutta pot, 270 Club, Pro Shop money, pigeon side bets, and para mutual bets, not to mention, the coveted Team Championship!*

*The men's club will be kicking off the event with a May 6 calcutta auction where all teams will be auctioned to the highest bidder, here's specific details on the calcutta and the 2021 Team Championship..*

### *CALCUTTA AUCTION*

*Each team will be up for bid in a live auction with the minimum bid starting at \$300, total money raised in the auction will be distributed to teams placing in the tournament (usually 1st thru 8th place but can vary depending on size of the field). Once the highest bidder is determined, the bidder owns that team and will cash in on any winnings if that team places in the tournament. If the bidder/owner is not one of the team participants, the bidder/owner is required to offer one half of the team ownership to the team participants. The team participants then have the option to decline ownership or pay the bidder/owner one half of the purchased price and will then own one half of their team and will share any winnings available with the bidder/owner.*

### *270 CLUB*

*\$20 shares will be sold for the 270 Club prior to the start of round one. Participants have the option to purchase a share of any team or teams in the field at \$20 per share. Any team scoring 270 or better for the four rounds will qualify for the 270 purse. The purse will be distributed equally to all owners of a share in any team who qualifies for the 270 Club.*

## *PARA MUTUAL*

*Prior to each round, para-mutual betting will be available to participants. Our traditional "horse race" style betting allows you to place a dollar amount on any team to win, place, or show for each round and the 3 day overall.*

## *PIGEON BETS*

*Your team has the option to place a wager with any team in the field. The pigeon sheet will help you account for all teams you've engaged in competition. The dollar amount is at the discretion of the participants however a typical pigeon bet would look something like this, Round 1 score \$5, Round 2 score \$5, Final round score \$5, and Overall score \$5, total \$20. All pigeon bets are settled after the final round.*

## *THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CALCUTTA AUCTION OR ANY GAMING COMPETITION*

*\$50 PER PLAYER ENTRY/ \$100 per team*

*The Oakbrook Team Championship is open to all current Oakbrook Men's Club Members. We request payment of team's \$100 entry fee at the time of sign up. Please sign up on the "big board" in the Pro Shop or call 253-584-8770.*

## *SUMMER RULES*

*We will play summer rules for this year's tournament. The ball will be played down through the green with one exception. For our first round, 2 man scramble, players are allowed 6" through the green. Players will gain free relief from all white marked areas.*

## *10 STROKE DIFFERENTIAL*

*A 10 stroke differential is in effect. If any team's handicap difference is more than 10 strokes, a handicap deduction will be made to the higher handicap player to satisfy the 10 stroke maximum. We encourage all teams with a larger than 10 stroke differential to participate, in fact, several teams compete each year where the differential has impacted their handicaps.*

*TEAMS ARE NOT DISQUALIFIED BECAUSE OF THE 10 STROKE DIFFERENTIAL.*

## *HANDICAPS*

*All team's handicaps will be adjusted for the tournament. 2 man scramble handicaps will be adjusted to 35% of the lower handicapped player, 15% to the higher handicap. 90% of each players index will be adjusted for the 2nd round Best Ball. Players receive their full handicap for the final round.*

## *SIDE GAMES*

*The Men's Club will support a daily "KP" competition. Specific holes and payout purse has yet to be determined. There will also be a daily skins game available.*

## *TOURNAMENT TEE TIME POLICY*

*In earlier rounds, members with personal commitments or emergencies will receive special consideration on a case by case basis from tournament chairs on the adjustment of their tee times. Adjustments will not be granted for convenience only. The prevention of any player gaining a real or perceived competitive advantage is our highest priority. The final round tee times will be strictly enforced with no special exceptions.*
